Attendance at lectures, classes and examinations

- 1. In accordance with the Order of the Ministry of Science and Higher Education dated May 9, 2012, medical students are obliged to complete the minimum of 5700 hours of tuition during their studies at the home university.
- 2. Requirements concerning attendance at classes (lectures, seminars, practical classes) and other activities included in the curriculum should be made known as soon as they start.
- 3. Failure of a student to fulfill the requirements set for admission to sit an examination or unexcused failure to sit an examination on a prescribed date results in the student being denied the right to sit an examination on first term basis.
- 4. Student's absence at the examination on the scheduled date may be excused by institute director if an application in this matter is made within seven days following the date of this examination.
