



SUMMER CLERKSHIP OVERVIEW

PROGRAM OF STUDY	YEAR	FIELD OF CLERKSHIP
DDS program	1	Health care organization; General surgery, internal diseases or maxillo-facial surgery

OBJECTIVES	Acquaint student with health care organization system and the operation system of the hospital wards
LOCATION	<i>Health care organization:</i> outpatient clinics, medical care units, medical departments (general medicine or dentistry) or hospitals. <i>Medical rotation:</i> hospital wards (general surgery, internal medicine or maxillofacial surgery).
DURATION	4 weeks (2 + 2), 120 h (60 h + 60 h) (5 days/week, 6 h/day).
SUPERVISION	Hospital manager/ head of clinic/ unit/ department/ward, assigns a medical professional to serve as preceptor. The preceptor is responsible for completing the clerkship schedule and grants credits.
CREDITING	Credit is granted for acquiring knowledge and skills specified in the program of clerkship and confirmed through filling out the Certificate of Summer Clerkship Completion (provided by the JU MC SME).
PROGRAM OF CLERKSHIP	During the clerkship student should: in health care organization rotation: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. learn about operation and computerization of health care units;2. learn the principles of personal data protection;3. learn the principles of medical record keeping, circulation and filing;4. learn the principles of diagnosis and medical services coding system; in medical rotation: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. acquire basic skills in history taking and physical examination;2. assist at medical examinations and procedures;3. participate and assist in patients consultations;4. perform pulse, blood pressure and body temperature measurements;5. change small dressings;6. help with providing hygiene services to patients;7. learn principles of medical first aid.
