PROGRAM OF STUDY	YEAR	FIELD OF CLERKSHIP
DDS program	3	DENTAL SURGERY – Part 1

OBJECTIVES	developing students' theoretical knowledge and practical skills of general dentistry while assisting the dentist during dental procedures		
LOCATION	dental office, outpatient clinic and dental clinic		
DURATION	<b>4 weeks, 120 h</b> (5 days/week, 6 h/day); can be completed over summer vacation months only (July - September).		
SUPERVISION	A dentist designated by the head of the outpatient clinic/clinic/dental office. The designated mentor is responsible for completing the clerkship schedule.		
CREDITING	Credit is granted for acquiring knowledge and skills specified in the program of clerkship and confirmed through filling out the Certificate of Summer Clerkship Completion (provided by the JU MC SME) and appropriate entries in the procedure book.		
PROGRAM OF CLERKSHIP	<ol> <li>Dental examination of a patient.</li> <li>Familiarization with principles of record keeping in a dental office.</li> <li>Active assistance during dental procedures.</li> <li>Performing oral hygiene instruction.</li> <li>Learning the principles of local anesthesia in dentistry.</li> <li>Broadening knowledge on instruments and dental equipment.</li> <li>Acquiring further information on instruments sterilizing, as well as documenting it in dental office.</li> <li>If the preceptor decides that the student is able to perform the following procedures during a given dental clerkship, the student may perform:         <ul> <li>Simple treatment of carious lesions</li> <li>Supra- and subgingival scaling</li> </ul> </li> </ol>
