Using mobile phones and other electronic devices during classes at the JU MC Faculty of Medicine

Due to numerous comments from academic teachers, I would like to remind students of the Faculty of Medicine of the need to refrain from using mobile phones and other electronic devices during classes: lectures, seminars and labs.

The phone should be on silent during classes. If a telephone or other electronic device constitutes a teaching aid (e.g. as a calculator or to search for information on the Internet), they may only be used upon explicit instructions from the teacher.

In emergencies, when the use of a telephone or other electronic devices for private matters is necessary during classes, it is required to obtain the consent of the teacher and temporarily leave the room where the classes are taking place.

Failure to comply with these rules may result in dismissal from classes and failure to pass them.
