TERMS AND CONDITIONS

("Terms and Conditions")

§ 1

Date and duration

- 1. The White Coat Ceremony will take place on 26 September 2025 (hereinafter referred to as the "Event").
- 2. The Participant acknowledges that participation in the Event and entry into the buildings and areas where the Event is held (see paragraph 4 below) is equivalent to acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
- 3. Detailed information about the Event and its program is available on the Event website: www.medschool.uj.edu.pl
- 4. The Event will take place in designated areas of the following organizational units of the Jagiellonian University (hereinafter referred to as "JU"):
 - 1. JU CM Educational and Conference Centre, ul. Św. Łazarza 16, Kraków
- 5. JU reserves the right to exclude the units listed in paragraph 4 above from the tour or to change them, with prior notice provided via the Event website mentioned in paragraph 3 above.
- 6. During the Event, guests will be presented with activities prepared for them, which will be defined in separate programs. These programs will be published on the Event website (www.medschool.uj.edu.pl) and in the registration system for the Event.

§ 2

Registration for the Event

- 1. A Participant of the Event is any person who takes part in the Event.
- 2. Participation in the Event is possible on the basis of prior registration. The above does not apply to activities marked in the programme with "no registration", in which persons who have not registered can also take part.
- 3. It is not possible to take part in activities that require prior registration unless a registered Participant opts out.
- 4. Registration is carried out by providing the Participant's first name, surname, and photo ID, and is conducted in person before the Event.
- 5. Registration will begin on 26 September 2025 at 10:15 and will continue until all places are filled.

§3

Rules of participation in the Event

- 1. Participants accept the established rules of the Event and its programme and undertake not to alter or disrupt the Event.
- 2. For activities for which registration is not required, admission is determined on a first-come, first-served basis. If the number of places is exhausted, the JU reserves the right to refuse admission to the activity.
- 3. Before entering the Event, the participant is required to take part in pre-registration confirmation activities.
- 4. The activities referred to in paragraph 3 above will take place separately in each of the participating organisational units of the Jagiellonian University indicated in §1 paragraph 4 of the Regulations.

- 5. The obligation to carry out activities confirming registration referred to in paragraph 3 above shall not apply to activities which are marked in the programme with the annotation "no registration".
- 6. The Event can be attended by organised groups accompanied by a supervisor, as well as individuals.
- 7. Minors may only participate in the Event in the presence of adult guardians or parents who are responsible for the care of the minors during their participation in the Event.
- 8. JU plans to carry out photo coverage of the Event for documentation (e.g. reports and statements), information (available on the Event website and other JU websites with information about the Event and its proceedings), promotion (e.g. on the Event website and other JU websites, JU social media profiles) and archiving (in terms of recordings and photo coverage).
- 9. By taking part in the Event, the Participant agrees to the recording and use of his/her image for the purposes indicated in paragraph 8 above, without being entitled to remuneration for the above. Consent covers the dissemination by the JU of the image captured in connection with participation in the Event by: recording, reproduction using any technique, dissemination, use, marketing, lending, public performance, insertion, display, reproduction, broadcasting, making available to the public, archiving, including in particular on JU websites, on JU social media profiles, at JU promotional events.

§ 4

Amendment of the Terms and Conditions

- 1. The Terms and Conditions are made available to participants on the unit's website: www.uj.edu.pl, in a downloadable version, as well as in front of the entrance to the individual JU buildings participating in the event, as referred to in §1.4.
- 2. The JU reserves the right to amend the Terms and Conditions in particular due to a change in generally applicable legislation and the need to adapt the Terms and Conditions to this change, a change in the programme of the Event, an increase in security measures accompanying the Event.
- 3. The amendment to the terms and conditions will come into effect as soon as they are published on the Event website.

§ 5

Safety rules

- 1. Participants are obliged to observe the safety rules, health, safety and fire regulations in force on the premises where the Event is organised and, in this respect, to follow the instructions given by the Event personnel or security services.
- 2. Participation in the Event may only take place in designated rooms and areas, in accordance with the applicable programme and order of the Event. It is forbidden to stay outside the designated area of the Event.
- 3. JU is not responsible for items left or lost during the Event and for items left in clothing or backpacks returned to the cloakroom, or in other public areas of the Event and JU.
- 4. The provision of paragraph 3 above shall apply mutatis mutandis to bicycles, cars and other vehicles left on JU premises.
- 5. JU is entitled to vet baggage and use a metal detector to limit the possibility of dangerous tools being brought into the Event area. The above authorisation is for the safety of the Participants, and failure by JU to allow the above authorisation to be exercised in relation to a person shall be tantamount to a waiver of participation in the Event.
- 6. Participants taking part in the event may not possess or bring into the Event and JU premises:
 - a. any weapons, ammunition, or objects considered dangerous (e.g. knife),
 - b. explosive, flammable and toxic materials,

- c. long umbrellas,
- d. animals, with the exception of guide dogs accompanying persons with disabilities.
- 7. During the event, the manifestation of world views, including in particular political views, is prohibited. JU prohibits commercial, promotional, advertising activities on the Event site, subject to cases where the entity in question has obtained separate permission from the JU.
- 8. Persons who are intoxicated or under the influence of intoxicants, behaving in a manner that could endanger the safety of other Participants and JU, who disrupt the order of the Event, or violate generally accepted norms of behaviour in public places are prohibited from entering the Event. The Event staff shall be entitled to oblige the person referred to in the preceding sentence to leave the Event's premises.
- 9. The Event staff, shall a Participant disturb public order, are entitled to:
 - verify the Participant's documents in order to establish his/her identity,
 - b) check the contents of the Participant's luggage and clothing, particularly if there's a suspicion that the Participant is in possession of items referred to in §5.6,
 - c) call on the Participant to behave accordingly,
 - d) require the Participant to leave the Event area and use all available means, including detention until the arrival of the Police, if the Participant continues to behave in a manner that violates the safety and order of the Event, despite prior warning.
- 10. JU shall not be liable for incidents resulting from Participants' failure to comply with the Terms and Conditions from Participants' failure to follow JU's instructions and from the instructions of Event staff and services responsible for security and order.
- 11. The Participant shall be fully liable for damages to property or personnel of the JU (employees and associates) caused by him/her or persons under his/her care. The Participant shall also be liable to other Participants to the same extent as above.
- 12. In order to ensure security on the Event site, JU may use CCTV covering the whole Event site as well as specific parts of it.
- 13. JU prohibits smoking and the consumption of alcohol and intoxicants on the Event premises.
- 14. In the event that a threat to the life and health of Participants is perceived, the Participant is obliged to inform the Event staff immediately.

§ 6 Processing of personal data

- 3. The Participant's personal data will be processed for:

- b) to carry out Photoreports and Videoreports* of the Conference for documentation, information, educational and didactic purposes, promotion of the Parties and the Conference/Event itself, archiving with regard to personal data of the Participants in the form of their image on the basis of the permission granted in accordance with the Act on Copyright and Related Rights pursuant to Art. 6(1)(e) GDPR, i.e. in the public interest, which is the organisation of conferences and other events by universities in accordance with Article 11 of the Law on Higher Education and Science.
- c) to ensure the security of the Conference/Event in accordance with the JU's Video Surveillance Regulations available at https://bip.uj.edu.pl/ and the Information Obligation concerning image processing in video surveillance available at https://iod.uj.edu.pl/monitoring-wizyjny on the basis of Article 6(1)(e) of the GDPR - with regard to video surveillance data
- 4. Provision of personal data by the Participant:
 - a) with regard to the data referred to in point. 3(a) above is necessary for the conclusion of the contract and participation in the Conference/Event;
 - b) with regard to the data referred to in point. 3(b) above is voluntary;
 - c) with regard to the data referred to in point. 3(c) above is voluntary, but failure to provide it, due to the obligation to ensure the safety of Participants, will result in the inability to participate in the Event.
- 5. The Participant's personal data provided in the registration form will not be shared with third parties. - 6. The Participant's personal data will/will not * be transferred to third parties (outside the European Economic Area) nor international organisations.
- 7. Recipients of the Participant's personal data are entities providing IT support for the organisation of the Conference/Event including the entity providing the software used to register for the event.
- 8. The Participant's personal data provided in the registration form will be processed until the end of the Event and thereafter for the period of limitation of claims that may arise from participation in the
 - The Participant's personal data in the form of an image will be processed within the scope of a report from the Conference/Event on JU websites and JU social media profiles until the Participant raises an objection. Video surveillance data will be processed for a maximum of 3 months.
- 9. The participant has the right to: be informed about the processing of personal data and the rights applicable under the GDPR, access and rectification of their data, as well as the right to have personal data deleted from the administrator's files (unless further processing is necessary to fulfil a legal obligation or to establish, pursue or defend claims), and the right to restrict processing, transfer data, and object to processing in the cases and under the conditions specified in the GDPR.
- 10. The Participant's personal data will not be subject to automated decision-making or profiling.
- 11. The Participant has the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection if he/she considers that the processing of his/her personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR.

§ 7 Final provisions

- 1. JU reserves the right to cancel the Event, change its programme and formula. JU will announce the cancellation of the Event on the Event website referred to in §1.3. JU will not be liable to Participants for any compensation or damages on this account, nor for any reimbursement of costs incurred in order to participate in the Event.
